

- Today Bill Reade will present for 15-20 minutes his overall approach to photography.


































































Masking

Masking

- Generally speaking, Masking is the process (during a phot editing) to "isolate" part of the photo in order to do editing just on that part.
- Masking has been a key feature of Photoshop for many years (it was introduced with Photoshop 3.0 in September 1994).
- Over the years, this functionality has been added to a lot of Image Editing programs.
- * The Masking process has been always a somewhat time consuming effort especially if the area of the photo one wants to isolate is quite complicated (think of a head shot with hair in the air).

Masking

- Fortunately, the software companies have enhanced significantly the masking capability of their programs and today the whole process is much simpler and faster.
- Two weeks ago, Adobe has introduced new versions of Photoshop and Lightroom with major improvements of the masking ability with extensive use of Al (Artificial Intelligence).
- The new improvements are very similar for both products and the following video present them as implemented in Lightroom.
